

Employment Verification using the "The Work Number"



The Work Number is an automated service that provides instant employment and income verification. This is a secure service which is used when applying for a mortgage or loan, reference checking, and any other instance where proof of employment is needed.

The Work Number is a great benefit for IDEX Employees, it provides quick turnaround for employment and/or income verification and provide 24 hour / 7 day web and telephone access. Employees maintain control of the release of information.

For Employees who ONLY need proof of employment, not income (follow instructions below)	For Employees who need both proof of employment AND income verification, for banks, employers and others (follow instructions below)
